What I'm always trying to do is not instill fear in people. I just don't want people to think about 'Oh my God.' My Keurig machine is hurting me! is more important to keep in mind. But forget the bacteria for 1 second. Another main reason you need to clean a coffee maker on a regular basis is to prevent mineral deposits from water, or occasional mildew colonies, from collecting in your machine's reservoirs and tubes, according to Becky Rapinchuk of Clean Mama. Limescale - The chalk, often common around faucets, can accumulate in the cubicle, and if left unattended long enough, it can cause other problems. Allowing mineral deposits to accumulate will eventually not get hot enough, preventing them from drinking lukewarm coffee as well as tasting the full taste of coffee. And it is a losing situation that no one should experience the first thing in the morning. So, how the hell do I clean my Keurig coffee maker? The first thing to do was unplug the machine and then start to disassemble it completely. Wash reservoirs, lids, drip trays, covers, K-cup holders and funnel with warm water and soap. Just be careful about the needle from the K cup holder. They sometimes say blood, sweat, tears, fine, hard work when they say that doesn't mean they mean? The internal parts are used with a wet towel to wipe the outside of the machine while air drying. If you already find mineral deposits, the manufacturer suggests soaking chickenpox in white vinegar and helping to break down pesky sediments. Tell me more about that white vinegar. If I have learned anything about cleaning over the years, it is plain white vinegar which is one of the best all-around cleaning products on the market (simple and cheap, too!). Fortunately, it doesn't match for the acidity of vinegar that will quickly break down mineral deposits, Riker explained. (Notable: If you choose to do so, you can buy a special descaler solution in Kerig.) To do this, assemble a new one. Make sure your store is empty and auto-off function (if you have one) off the machine (go, you!), Fill the reservoir all the way with white vinegar, depending on how long (no more vinegar, more vinegar) since you finally did this and then run the machine through the brewing cycle (without an inside K cup!). Discard a glass of delicious hot vinegar you've just made and continue running the cycle until the light comes to add water. At this point, Riker recommends sitting on the machine for 4 hours so that the vinegar can sit warm inside the machine. This helps to disassemble the remaining stubborn deposits. At the end of the day, discard the remaining vinegar in the machine. After that, rinse the reservoir, fill it with water, and just run the water cycle until the brew edits no longer smell the vinegar. When you reach that point, it means that the vinegar has been completely flushed, and you are ready to get back to making coffee (blessed!). How often do you need to clean the KewRig? I can't remember the last morning when I didn't start with a cup of coffee. If Keurig is a daily use mechanism, the manufacturer recommends that you take some care every day, even if you wipe it quickly with a microfiber cloth. As for disassembling the entire machine to clean the entire machine once a month and giving a deep cleaning, the maker says that you will do better than your neighbors, that's for sure. How often you need to reduce the scale of the currig depends on the mineral composition of the water. In general, manufacturers point out that when using distilled water in a machine, it is not necessary to descale frequently. What are some other tips for keeping your Kerig machine clean? Apparently! To prevent bacterial growth in the reservoir, the maker recommends that you do not leave the water hanging there if you do not use the machine for a long period of time (like, if you go out of town for more than a week). Also, whenever you brew something sweet in a machine such as hot chocolate, brew a regular water cycle later to clean up the remaining sugar. This will allow you to brew the Keurig machine stronger and longer, and will give you more reasons to treat yourself in the second cup.
